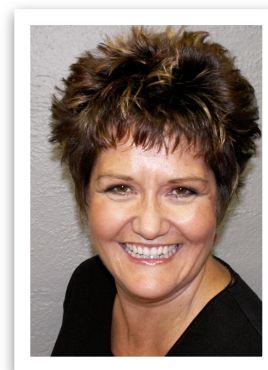

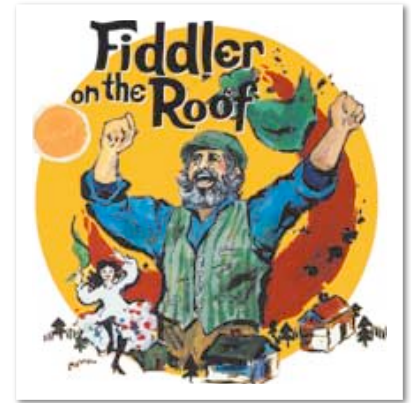

Saturday, September 8:	9-5 p.m.	- Vocal auditions
Saturday, September 8:	4:30 - 5:30	- Kids 11 - 15 (full hour)
Saturday, September 8:	2 p.m.	- Dance auditions
Sunday, September 9:	9-12 p.m.	- Vocal auditions
Sunday, September 9:	2-5 p.m.	- Call Backs

You will be asked to stay until a 5 minute movement break is scheduled with the choreographer (within 1/2 hour of your arrival of your audition). Dance auditions are separate from vocal auditions. These auditions start at 2:00 p.m. on Saturday Sept. 8. All dancers must also book a vocal audition time. Select your audition piece from a Broadway musical that is similar in style to *Fiddler* or a song from *Fiddler* is fine but no rock. Bring your sheet music with you - you will have an accompanist.
